5. President's Report

Season is running quite smoothly and we're nearly half way through. Thank you to all clubs for paying their fees on time, even one club paid twice which they will be credited for in the coming season.

6. Treasurer's Report (given to delegates)

(a) Moved Graham Sandman (Treasurer), seconded Lorraine Cram (East Keilor) that the Treasurer's Report be accepted – **Carried.**

7. Match and Permit Committee Report

- Some Pennants needed to be reprinted and they are now available to be collected. There has been some issues with the supplier and we are currently looking to rectify these issues before the next batch of pennants are printed.
- Light testing is well under way. Reminder to all clubs that they must reach the minimum 200 lux on all courts to be used for competition. Light reading reports will be sent to all clubs when readings have been undertaken.
- Season is going well so far. Few defaults in the ladies early in the season but they seem to have slowed down now. The ladies ladders were delayed due to a technical glitch which has now been rectified.
- Results are still entered manually even though the results are submitted via internet. Late results delay this process which is why we ask that all results are posted within 24 hours of the match being completed. When the results were posted in the mail they weren't received by co-ordinator for at least 48 hours so this new system can make process a little quicker. We are currently looking at developing a system where the results can be calculated as soon as they are entered online rather than entering results in manually. This would enable the ladder to be updated automatically.
- Changes were made at the AGM and further changes for the by-laws will be distributed to all clubs prior to the next delegates' meeting.
- Additional Registrations close Ladies 25/10, Mens 27/10 and Mixed 2/11.
- A reminder given to all clubs that if the Additional Registration form is submitted electronically then you do not need to sign the form.
- An additional registration can be considered prior to a player actually playing 3 times.
- Team entries for Autumn 2012 close 2nd December at 8pm, email to the Chairman.
