7. Match and Permit Committee Report

- The finals ran quite smoothly last season. First week of the men's finals were a washout. Some host clubs did advise teams that courts were flooded and has been closed. It seems a sensible solution for a host clubs to call a washout over the phone. The M&P committee and currently looking at this idea and will be discussed further at October meeting.
- Team entries were fairly steady. Ladies were a little higher, mixed was a little lower and men's remained the same. Mixed C+1 Keilor Park has withdrawn and has been replaced with a bye. Clubs were notified.
- Not too many issues have arisen so far this season. Reminder to all clubs that an additional registration can be submitted prior to a player playing 3 matches. Additional registrations have been received due to players being missed on the team entry forms, even if they were accidentally missed this will be still be considered as an additional registration as grading is done on the players that are submitted on the team entry sheet. Also be mindful of the spelling of names on team entry sheets. If there are any errors in the spelling of names please notify the Chairman.
- The match result books need to be used for every match. If there is a discrepancy found with the result placed online a hard copy will be requested by the Co-ordinator to verify results. If there is no hard copy available this may result in a null and void match. Please remember to put full names of all players on the sheets.
- There have been a few lighting problems so far this season. Reminder to all clubs that if courts are unplayable they should contact the Chairman to look at relocating matches.
- Away teams are not to contact home teams to see if there is a possibility of a washout.

8. General Business

- Oak Park Requested whether the subsidy for lighting of finals matches could be reviewed due to inflation. This will be looked into by the Management Committee and they will report back at the October meeting.
- Tennis Australia CEO Steve Wood resigned and will be finishing up in September, has done a great job.
- The U.S open starts this week. Sam Stosur has recently parted ways with her coach and Marion Bartoli has retired.
- Tennis Victoria Notification of the October AGM has been received including paperwork for voting. There is a election for Vice-President and Associations director. Maria Keys is the current Vice-President.
