Our challenge in the past year has been to ensure that we have the people and resources to keep the competitions running smoothly and in a timely fashion. And of course there is Larry Pelly. Same goes to Gaye Olney who answers all the calls and records the information for Larry and me to process.

Cathryn Ryan and Ian Openshaw have spent many hours measuring and cataloguing the lighting levels of the clubs for the Association passing the results on to Sue Malins for compiling and organising the results for the clubs. They have been so busy that they wore the old light meter out and we had to purchase a new one.

While we all have many demands on our time, I am always pleased to see that our General Meetings are well attended.

I look forward to seeing each of you at the meetings and functions during the coming year.

Match and Permit Committee Report 2009/10

This year was my first as Chairman of the Match and Permit Committee. Thanks go to all the Grade Coordinators and my fellow members of the Committee for their efforts assisting me in my role and ensuring the three competitions run smoothly. I have also been greatly assisted by all the Club Delegates who have ensured team entries are submitted on time, have followed up any queries and have ensured their teams are well organised.

The North Suburban Night Tennis Competition remains in a very healthy position. The Men's competition continues to be the largest with 29 grades and 228 teams registered to play this Spring, meaning almost all the courts within the Association are full on a Thursday night. The Ladies competition has remained stable with 19 grades and 151 teams in Spring 2010 season. However, the number of Mixed grades has fallen away slightly with 17 grades and 135 teams participating in Spring 2010.

The Match and Permit Committee continues to look at ways to improve the running of the competition. Spring 2010 will see an online results system implemented for the first time. The system aims to get results to the Grade Coordinators faster than is currently possible through the regular mail, allowing Coordinators to process results more quickly and provide updated ladders faster. The online results system will also allow all players to view the details of all matches played (including player names and set scores) on the NSNTA website, greatly increasing the information available to all players. Hopefully the system will be embraced by players, and will overcome some of the delays experienced in the past.

The Association has also continued to regularly check the lighting levels at all courts used within the competition. Thanks go to Cathryn Ryan, Ian Openshaw and Peter Olney for devoting their time to this important task and to Sue Malins for her efforts in collating all the light readings. As facilities and lights are upgraded, it is pleasing to see court lighting levels across the competition continue to improve. In the next few months, the Committee will propose a change to the current lighting policy, requiring a uniform minimum lighting level of 200 lux for all courts used in competition play, starting from the end of 2012. Currently a lower minimum level of 150 lux applies to courts where the lighting was installed prior to 1997, resulting in inconsistent rulings being made for different courts. Only 21 out of 238 courts (8%) are currently below 200 lux, with only six below 180 lux. It is hoped that with a two year lead-in period and guidance from the Association, all Clubs will be able to meet this new standard, greatly improving the quality of lighting for all players.

Whilst participation levels are strong and matches continue to be played in good spirits, the one issue that continues to frustrate Grade Coordinators is inaccurately completed or incomplete match result cards, particularly in the Men's Competition. This creates extra work for the Coordinators who then must chase teams to provide the correct details. In Autumn 2010, the Association aimed to provide more information to Clubs about these issues and hopefully this will be passed on to teams to prevent these issues continuing in the future, and reduce fines incurred by Clubs. The online results system will also provide registered player information to all teams, hopefully reducing the number of unlisted emergencies and in turn reducing the number of fines.

In conclusion, and on behalf of all participating Clubs, I would like to thank the following Grade Coordinators and tireless workers of the Match and Permit Committee: Mara Cassar, Toni Cudmore, Sue Malins, Ian Openshaw, Roberta Paddle, Cathryn Ryan and Lynne Seddon as well as the members of the Association's Executive: Peter Olney, Maria Keys and Graham Sandman.
