### **President's Report**

Again, I am happy to report that the NSNTA is still a vibrant and strong Association providing a growing night tennis competition for the residents of Melbourne's Northern Suburbs.

On behalf of all member clubs I would like to thank Robert McDonald, Chairman of Match and Permit; Toni Cudmore, our Honorary Secretary; Sue Malins, our Assistant Secretary; Graham Sandman, our Treasurer; Maria Keys, our Vice President; and the members of the Match and Permit Committee: Mara Cassar, Ian Openshaw and Cathryn Ryan for their time and effort in managing the competitions and business end of the Association.

The committee members spend countless hours doing the jobs that need to be done to ensure that the competitions are run well and with a minimum of fuss. However, we need new people to join in this task as it is being left to fewer people to keep the systems and work going. We acknowledge that it is difficult to find people who can volunteer their time today, so we must therefore look at alternatives, such as paid administrators or competition coordinators. Whatever the outcome, this is going to cost the Association to maintain the standards of competition that we currently enjoy.

Robert McDonald has again been extremely busy in his role as Chairman. In the last couple of months he has embarked on the daunting task of re-writing the Association's Constitution – a task that even the more hardy of us have been trying to come to grips with. Many of our member clubs are also probably grappling with the same task. Hopefully this task will be completed in time for the August General Meeting for consideration. Thanks Robert for the hard yards.

The Association also takes this opportunity to thank Gabriel Pelly of Pellysoft, for his continued support to our IT systems and to Tony Borrell for his services as the Association's Auditor. For the record, I'd like to also pay my thanks to Gaye Olney who answers all the calls and records the information for Rounds 14 and the finals.

Cathryn Ryan and Ian Openshaw have again been spending numerous hours measuring and cataloguing the lighting levels of the clubs for the Association. Sue Malins for compiling the results and they are as usual are available for the clubs to examine, upon request.

Thanks to all of the Clubs who continue to support the Association by providing facilities and teams and also attending our General Meetings. We very look forward to and welcome your ongoing support.

I look forward to seeing each of you at the meetings and functions during the coming year.

Peter Olney President It is pleasing to report that over the last 12 months, participation in the Association's competitions has continued to grow. The Mens competition continues to be the largest and comprised a record 31 grades in Autumn 2013 with 241 teams and 1,533 players registered. The Ladies competition remained at 20 grades with 997 registered players in 154 teams and the Mixed competition is steady at 18 grades with 1,103 registered players in 142 teams in Autumn 2013. This made a total of over 3,600 players in 538 teams from 51 Clubs. In April 2013 Riverside Golf and Tennis Centre re-affiliated with the NSNTA and will enter teams for the Spring 2013 season.

The Committee continues to look at ways to improve the administration of the competition and further refine the online results system. From the start of the Spring 2012 season, players entering match results have been required to input their name and a contact phone number when submitting the result. This has greatly assisted the Competition Coordinators to follow up any queries or anomalies in the results.

Disputes about washouts continue to be an issue for the Match and Permit Committee, with several protests received during the year following disagreements between teams as to whether courts were playable. In April 2013, the Association issued written Washout Procedures which clarify the processes to be followed in the event of wet weather. The focus of the procedures is to encourage teams to attempt to dry courts and not call washouts prematurely. It is hoped these procedures will reduce the number of disputes over washouts in future.

In October 2012, a proposal was put forward to amend the By-laws to remove the option of a Club withdrawing a team. This followed a significant number of withdrawals in the preceding seasons, which unfortunately on a number of occasions resulted in two Byes in the same grade. The change to the By-laws was not supported by the required number of Clubs, and the rule therefore has remained unchanged. However, discussion of this issue has hopefully highlighted to Clubs the importance of fulfilling their commitment once a team is entered and the negative impact that withdrawing a team can have on players from other Clubs. Since the proposal, it is pleasing to see that the number of withdrawals has reduced with only one team withdrawn in Spring 2012 and two in Autumn 2013.

Lighting levels across the Association have continued to improve with almost all courts now meeting the 200 lux requirement. Thanks go to those Clubs that have taken action in the last 12 months to improve their lighting and also to Cathryn Ryan and Ian Openshaw for the time they have devoted to checking lighting levels across the Association.

I would like to acknowledge the support of all the Club Delegates who have made my role easier by ensuring team entries are submitted on time, queries are followed up quickly and teams are well organised. I would also particularly like to thank the Grade Coordinators and tireless workers of the Match and Permit Committee: Mara Cassar, Toni Cudmore, Sue Malins, Ian Openshaw and Cathryn Ryan as well as the members of the Association's Executive: Peter Olney, Maria Keys and Graham Sandman.

The Match and Permit Committee recently put out a call for volunteers to assist in the role of Competition Coordinators. A good response was received and two new Competition Coordinators, Larry Pelly and Carolyn Seinor, have been recruited for the Spring 2013 season. I thank them for their willingness to volunteer their time to this role and ask all Club Delegates to do all they can to assist them in their new positions.

### **Treasurer's Report**

This is the thirtieth second (32) Treasurer's Report of the North Suburban Night Tennis Association Incorporated and my fifth (5); this report covers the financial year ending 30 June 2013.

Income and Expenditure statement shows a net loss as at 30 June 2013 of \$1,078.03 compared to the previous year a net profit of \$1,131.39.

The loss has occurred as the Association purchased new laptops/printers for the competition coordinators at a cost of \$1,982.68 and a new light meter that was purchased at a cost of \$536.80.

The association will continue to absorb the GST charges.

I would recommend that: -

- Team Fees remain at \$30.00 per team for the next 12 months
- Affiliation Fees remain at \$20.00 per club for the next 12 months

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the members of the Match and Permit and Management committees for their support and assistance they have extended to me as the association Treasurer.
