The Association remains steady with healthy participation numbers and in a strong financial position. The Mens competition continues to grow with record numbers while the Ladies competition remain strong and the Mixed competition slightly down on numbers.

Toni Cudmore has kept secretarial and correspondence items in order, this usually being the first point of contact with clubs. Assistant Secretary Cathryn Ryan has backed up Toni and managed the fixture, web, and by-laws upgrades and Graham Sandman has kept a close eye on our receipts and expenditure, maintaining our healthy financial position. Vice President Maria Keys keeps us all up to date with all things "Tennis Victoria" and keeps a steady view on proceedings.

The Match and Permit Committee headed by Robert McDonald have once again had an outstanding year; they have handled a mountain of work which includes, web upgrades, fixture preparation details, overseeing the grading and draws of the 3 competitions. Every time a club or player consults "the web" for whatever reason, it's in no small way attributed to Robert and Cathryn efforts. Robert and the M&P Committee are constantly reviewing the web, to make the web more user friendly and transparent. Also Robert and Cathryn head up the light testing committee, conducting regular club floodlight inspections. Well done to the Match and Permit Committee, Cathryn Ryan, Ian Openshaw, Steve Senior, Toni Cudmore, Mara Cassar and Russell Baldry together with Sue Malins for their efficient year in maintaining each of the competitions.

So, on behalf of all clubs, delegates and players I thank you all for your commitment in running the Association. But it's a two way street, we on the Executive and Match & Permit Committees also acknowledge the work carried out at club level by the clubs and delegates. Your support is greatly appreciated. Thankyou.

Finally, and as I have made reference to many times in the past, the Association is always on the lookout for more helpers to assist and take up some of the workloads. Some of us have been here a long time and may appear to be rusted on, so fresh blood would be greatly appreciated. If you are able to contribute please make contact with one of the Association officers.

Match & Permit Committee Report

This is my ninth report as Chairman of the Match and Permit Committee. I continue to enjoy the role and hope my efforts in a small way contribute to a fair and enjoyable competition for the players who participate.

I would like to start by thanking the other members of the Match and Permit Committee for their efforts and support. Their considered and thoughtful approach has helped make my job much easier and made me feel supported and part of a dedicated and effective team. I enjoy our discussions at committee meetings where we consider issues, debate interpretations of the rules, and look at ways to improve the competition.

However, as I look back on the past year for this report, I have reached the conclusion that the past twelve months have probably been the most difficult of my time on the Committee.

Over the past few years, I have noticed a trend of players and teams being less willing to accept rulings of the Committee and to more regularly seek detailed justifications of our decisions. This has resulted in much of the Committee's and my time over the last 12 months being spent considering appeals and drafting letters or emails to explain our decisions. Whilst we feel an obligation to provide additional information when requested, in a competition with over 500 teams, over 3,500 registered players, 220 additional registrations and approximately 1,500 matches played by emergencies each season, it places a significant additional burden on the Association volunteers to do so.

I remind all clubs that the NSNTA is their competition. The By-laws under which the competition operates have been approved by the required majority of clubs and many have worked very effectively for many years, during which the competition has continued to grow. I recognise some clubs and players may not agree with all of the rules. But unless they are changed, the Committee has a responsibility to uphold them.

The Committee has previously proposed changes that did not receive support from the required majority of clubs, such as making it harder to withdraw teams. The Committee respects the clubs' decision and continues to apply the existing rules. Similarly, clubs who disagree with the existing rules relating to washouts, walkovers or emergency players nonetheless need to accept they are the rules. I also hope clubs respect the Committee's decisions when we apply them.

If clubs can see areas for improvement, we encourage you to put up proposals to change the By-laws. If the required majority of clubs support them, then the rules will be changed. Delegates' meetings are a good opportunity for clubs to debate and discuss possible rule changes or improvements to the competition. However, many Match and Permit Committee discussions end with us concluding that although our current rules are not perfect, they are better than the alternatives. Churchill famously said "Democracy is the worst form of government, except for all the others".

As noted in Larry's President's report, over the past two seasons, participation in the Association's three competitions has remained strong. The overall number of teams has remained steady at 532 in Spring 2017 and 534 in Autumn 2018. However, there was a reduction in the number of Mixed teams and an increase in the number of Mens teams.

- The Ladies competition remained steady with 142 teams in Spring 2017 and 143 teams in Autumn 2018.
- Participation in the Mixed competition continued to reduce, with 135 teams entered in the Spring 2017 season and 129 in Autumn 2018.
- The Men's Competition continued to be the largest with 255 teams entered in the Spring 2017 season and 262 in Autumn 2018.

The growth in Mens competition has reached a point where most clubs' courts are at capacity on a Thursday night. Some clubs are struggling to find courts available to hire to accommodate all their teams. If your club has courts available that you are willing to hire, please let us know, so we can direct clubs to you if they are in need of courts.

At the last Annual General Meeting, the NSNTA adopted a Code of Conduct and complaint handling procedure. It has been pleasing that only a few complaints have been lodged with the Association since these were introduced. I hope the Code of Conduct has assisted players to understand the standard of behaviour expected in the NSNTA competitions, and in the long term will help to improve player behaviour.

Team withdrawals remain an issue with six withdrawals in Spring 2017 and seven in Autumn 2018. Unfortunately, on two occasions last season this resulted in two Byes in the same grade, significantly reducing the amount of tennis played by the players in the remaining teams.

Due to increasing other demands, the Committee did not have the opportunity to undertake the same amount of light testing as previous years. We hope to have the opportunity to focus more on this activity in the next 12 months so we can continue to ensure players have appropriate lighting levels for a night competition.


